## NUMISMATIC ESSENTIALS: AN INTRODUCTION TO COIN AND PAPER MONEY COLLECTING

Coin collecting is a vast hobby with unlimited ways to collect. The challenge is knowing where to start! This class will offer students the necessary resources to begin/continue their coin collecting journey with confidence. Students will learn about different types of coins and currency, as well as the tools and techniques for handling and storing their collection.

#### FEBRUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>

#### THE MODERN MINTING PROCESS

This class will provide students with a foundational understanding of the minting process through a live demonstration at our Mini Mint. We will explore the modern minting process through videos and hands-on activities, and students will also have the opportunity to view error coins!



#### MARCH 15<sup>TH</sup> THE IDES OF MARCH

Who was Julius Caesar? Learn about the fascinating world of ancient Rome and discover the story behind the coins he minted. We will explore the symbols and artwork on Roman coinage.

#### APRIL 19TH MAKING PAPER MONEY, PART 1: THE CANVAS

The ancient invention of paper revolutionized communication, commerce, and culture. In this class, we will explore the origins of paper and its evolution into the versatile material we use today. Students will learn about the process of papermaking, and will work hands-on to create their own paper!

#### MAY 17<sup>TH</sup> LEMONADE STAND ENTREPRENEURS

Students will learn about the fundamentals of economics through the hands-on experience of running a lemonade stand. They will acquire essential personal finance skills and gain a solid understanding of the basic economic principles that drive our economy.

#### JULY 19<sup>TH</sup> MAKING PAPER MONEY, PART 2: THE DESIGN PROCESS

We will dive deep into the fascinating world of banknote engraving, where human artistry meets machine. Students will explore their creative side by designing their own fantasy money using various mediums.

#### AUGUST 16<sup>TH</sup> GOLD PANNING

Experience the thrill of gold panning as you learn the techniques required to sift through sediment and discover gold! In this hands-on class, students will explore the history and tools behind gold panning, and practice the steps involved in separating gold from dirt and gravel.

#### SEPTEMBER 20<sup>TH</sup> THE SHAPE OF MONEY: ONE SIZE FITS ALL?

Did you know that hexagonal coins, coins with six sides, can symbolize the interconnectedness of community and trade? In this class, we will explore the symbolism and practicality of coins minted around the world, and the various shapes they take to represent different cultures and purposes.

#### OCTOBER 18<sup>TH</sup> LAYERS OF TIME: DISCOVERING PAST CIVILIZATIONS

Archaeology is like being a detective who travels back in time by finding pieces of an ancient puzzle buried in the earth. Students will work together in this mock archaeological dig to uncover relics of a past civilization.

#### NOVEMBER 15<sup>TH</sup> MONEY MUSEUM TOUR

Learn about the treasures on display at the Money Museum and explore the evolution of money, from ancient coins to modern banknotes.
