

## Numismatic Hall of Fame 2026 Historic Era Election ● Call for Nominations

The ANA is seeking nominations of worthy candidates for inclusion in its Numismatic Hall of Fame memorial located at its Headquarters in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Founded August 18, 1964, the Numismatic Hall of Fame perpetuates and enshrines the names of eminent numismatists, both modern and historic. International in its scope, it recognizes those whose accomplishments render their names symbolic and respected by their fellow numismatists. The citation is the highest honor possible to bestow upon any individual in the realm of numismatics.

The Numismatic Hall of Fame is sponsored by and under the perpetual administration of the American Numismatic Association. The Association regards itself as its trustee and under sacred obligation to administer its intent and purposes without bias or prejudice and under the rules and regulations set forth in the Numismatic Hall of Fame Constitution and By-Laws.

Eligible for immortalization in the Numismatic Hall of Fame are persons whose significant contributions to the advancement and awareness of the numismatic field, nationally or internationally without limitation, are deserving of recognition. Present or past membership in the American Numismatic Association is not a requirement.

#### Historic Era Numismatists shall be defined as:

Individuals deceased more than 25 years prior to induction.

- Nominations may be submitted by any ANA member other than a Young Numismatist.
- Each member is limited to two nominations at any election.
- To be valid, nominations MUST include **no less than 300 words of background or biographical information.**
- Nominations are accepted by ANA Headquarters through January 15, 2026.
