#### Scholarship Award:

A \$1,000 scholarship will be paid directly to the school you will attend. Students with a full class schedule can receive the \$1,000 scholarship for up to four years.

#### **Criteria for Eligibility:**

The applicant must be a United States Citizen and a graduating high school senior. The applicant must have at least a 3.0 "B" verifiable cumulative grade point average as of the application date.

The applicant must plan to attend a college, university or technical trade school within the United States.

The applicant must be a member in good standing of the American Numismatic Association.

**Selection Process:** Scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit. Each application is thoroughly reviewed by a selection committee. Emphasis is placed on numismatic interests and accomplishments.

**Tips for All Applicants:** Pay attention to detail. Your application should be concise and direct, reveal interesting things about yourself and describe how your strengths, achievements and passions make you a strong candidate for this scholarship. • The transcript can be sent to us in an officially sealed envelope from your school, or it can be mailed directly to the ANA Education Department
